## Fly of the Month Peeping Caddis



Cased caddis larva are amongst the largest items on the trout's menu. Imitation of this food source includes the burnt caddis, cased caddis and peeping caddis. The peeping caddis fly includes yarn or chenille burnt to look like the larva's dark head.

The pattern is designed to be fished on the bottom so weight is added using beads or lead.

The legs are imitated using partridge that wave around the head.

This pattern, when fished under an indicator, try an adult caddis pattern like an elk hair caddis or crystal Caddis as the indicator, in the shallows of a lake especially along a weed bed edge where feeding trout cruise, can elicit exciting takes when drawn very slowly along.

These are great flies for our upcoming Lake fishing trips.

Wet hook - size 8 - 14 long shank
Thread - brown 6/0 or 8/0
Caddis head - chartreuse or yellow chenille burnt
Tail - legs Partridge soft hackle
Body - hares fur dubbing
Body rib - Gold or copper wire
Weight - lead wire underbody
Head - Gold or copper bead

We Fish in high mountain lakes and saltwater along the open shore.

The movie is about streamers and surface flies.

We see the prey the streamers imitate and the different techniques Morten uses when fishing the flies.

Underwater cameras have provided stunning photography of trout taking the streamers and they have documented the trout's reactions to the streamers. Up close and under water.

Morten is well known for his innovative fly-tying techniques, which are both simple and effective.

In the fly-tying movie Morten shows exactly how he ties his streamers and surface flies. Most of them are his own effective patterns.

This is a movie you have to watch over and over again. It is very instructive and it shows new techniques. But it is also a movie with beautiful scenery, fishing actions and big trout.
