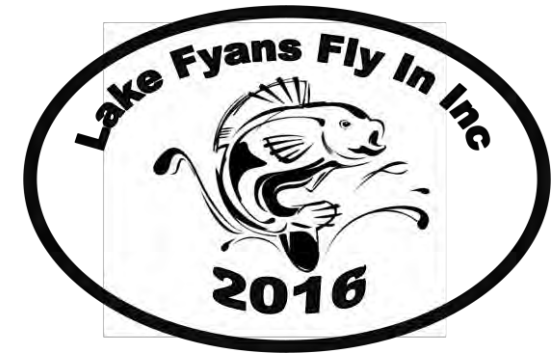

Fly-In Rules

1. The Fly In Committee shall not be held responsible for any damage to persons or property whilst attending the Fly In.
2. The Fly In is to be held on the second full weekend of October each year.
3. **ALL PARTICIPANTES MUST PAY FEES BY 28TH SEPTEMBER 2016 TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR COMPETITION.**
4. **Late registration will incur a fee of \$5.00 per person (Not per family).**
5. To be eligible for the various Trophies, all fishing will be conducted between the hours of 6pm Friday to 5pm Saturday and Midnight Saturday to 11am Sunday. Any fish found to be caught outside these hours shall be disqualified. All fish must be presented by 11.00am Sunday.
6. All trout must be a minimum 30cm in length to be eligible.
7. All fishing is to be done to the rules set out by the Fly In Committee.
8. All competitors must hold a current Victorian Licence if required to do so.
9. All fish to be weighed in uncleaned and must be caught on a Fly with the exception of Ladies and Juniors
10. Ladies and Juniors may weigh in any fish of legal size caught by legal means.
11. The Fly In Committee shall attempt to resolve any disputes to the satisfaction of all parties concerned. The Committee decision shall be final.
12. Fishing will only be at Lake Fyans, Lake Bellfield, Lake Wartook.
13. **NOTE: In the event of a draw the best condition Trout will be decided by the Committee.**
